

Met Officer convicted of possessing indecent child video – Richard Wright QC prosecutes

A Senior Metropolitan Police officer has been found guilty of possessing an indecent images on her phone.

Superintendent Novlett Robyn Williams was convicted after a three week trial at The Old Bailey.

Two other defendants were convicted of the same offence.

Richard Wright QC prosecuted the case.

During the trial Mr Wright QC told jurors it was not suggested the defendants had any sexual interest in the video but "each of them made serious errors of judgement about how to handle this video"

Sentence was adjourned to 26 November.
